Number 2

Welcome to this week's episode of Save our Planet. Today I want to talk about the Pacific Trash Vortex, which is destroying our ecosystem and killing marine life.

What exactly is the Pacific Trash Vortex? It's a huge floating pile of trash, twice the size of Texas and is officially the biggest landfill on planet earth, except it's floating in the ocean. Ninety percent of this floating trash is plastic. Eighty percent comes from the land and the other twenty percent comes from ships and oil platforms.

Who is responsible for this plastic trash? Well we humans are. We throw away about sixty billion tons of plastic every year so it's no wonder that these floating islands exist and are getting bigger!

The name Pacific Trash Vortex might give you a hint that it's in the Pacific Ocean. It's not a single floating island, but a pair of them. The first, the Eastern Garbage Patch floats between Hawaii and California while the second, the Western Garbage Patch floats between the East of Japan and the West of Hawaii.

No one knows exactly when the Pacific Trash Vortex began to form. We do know that it first began to form many years before it was first discovered in 1997 by a man called Charles Moore.
