Number 2

Countries often exchange gifts to help build good relationships. In 1912, the people of the United States received a gift of 3,000 cherry trees from Japan and they were planted in Washington D.C. They were given as a sign of friendship between the two countries, and although cherry trees normally live only for 60 years, some of them are still alive today.

In 1915, the United States decided to return the favor. They sent 60 dogwood trees to Japan, and over 100 years later, one of them still remains and it can be found at Tokyo Metropolitan Engei High School.

On the 100-year anniversary of Japan's gift to the United States, the American people decided to send another set of 3,000 dogwood trees back to Japan to remember the historic day. They selected healthy dogwood trees and sent a first set of 150 trees, which were planted in Tokyo in November 2012. Altogether, a total of 1,000 were planted in Tokyo, 561 in the Tohoku region to remember the tsunami victims, and the rest were sent to schools and other organizations throughout the country. These American dogwood trees can now be found in 30 prefectures in Japan, from Iwate in the north to Okinawa in the south, and they are growing in both the Nagasaki and Hiroshima Peace Parks.
