Number 2

Today, we'll learn about the Incas. They were an old group of people who lived in South America more than 500 years ago. They built their cities high in the mountains, not in the lowlands. Machu Picchu, a famous place they built, means "old mountaintop" in their language. The Incas made their buildings from stones cut to fit perfectly together. They did this to help their buildings stay strong during earthquakes. Their cities often had rectangular buildings without inside walls. The Incas had many stone roads and good ways to communicate between their cities. Runners could carry messages up to 240 kilometers in just one day. The Incas had good doctors who knew a lot about using plants as medicine. For example, they used tree pieces to cure upset stomachs. They also used cocoa leaves to help people with headaches. There is even proof that the Incas did brain surgeries! Today, people who came from the Incas are the Quechua-speaking farmers in the Andes. They make up about 45% of Peru's population. They mix farming and herding with simple technology. Their communities are close, with families usually marrying other Quechua-speakers. Much of their farming work is done together as a group.
